

Summary of 2024 World COPD Day Activities

- Argentina: Coordinator of the Respiratory Rehabilitation program at the Cardiovascular Diagnostic Institute of La Plata requesting material to carry out a workshop on International COPD Day
- Australia: Lung Foundation Australia are coordinating a range of activities for World COPD Day 2024
 - Meet and greets between members of parliament and consumers, and letters to health ministers in priority states in line with their COPD Blueprint
 - Healthcare Professional virtual event, where they launch and promote their brand new COPD-X Handbook
 - Consumer webinar to showcase lived experiences and provide people living with breathlessness and their carers to provide them with tools and information to support effective self-management practices
- Brazil: Requested World COPD Day image translated into Portuguese
- *China: The First Affiliated Hospital of Shandong First Medical University set up an activity to recruit subjects at high risk for COPD (one month prior to World COPD Day). The activity included:
 - The specialists made initial assessment of the participants, including smoking history, respiratory symptoms, signs, etc.
 - Then, relevant technicians explained the safety and procedure of lung function examination.
 - Smoking cessation education was also an important part in this activity, another group of medical workers enrolled individuals with smoking history and conducted initial smoking cessation interventions.
- Columbia: This year AIREPOC Fundación Neumológica Colombiana joined GOLD's initiative
 to celebrate World COPD Day by performing spirometry tests on people in the general
 community near the institution, using a mobile health bus NEUMOMOVIL of our social
 respiratory program. They also conducted a workshop with AIREPOC patients about oxygen
 therapy and how to adapt their activities of daily living
- Denmark: Creating 5 high-quality promotional videos for the WORLD COPD day for a large non-profit think-tank

- *India: Requested World COPD Day image to create flyer for KG College of Physiotherapy, to conduct an Awareness Session at KGiSL Institute of Technology on November 20, 2024; also Junior Resident at the Department of Pulmonary medicine Government Medical College Trivandrum Kerala India doing post graduate training in respiratory medicine in the Dept of Pulmonology <u>Photo here</u>
- Latvia: Head Nurse at Riga East University Hospital Pulmonary Clinic expressed interest in actively participating in the GOLD initiative to support World COPD Day

 offering spirometry screenings to staff across Pakistan, emphasizing its commitment to
 lung health and raising awareness about chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD)
